## **Where are the Miracles?**

*Read: Judges 6:11-14*

### **QUESTIONS (OR THINGS TO DO)**

How is everyone going? Does anyone have any answers to prayer/miracles/events that they want to share with the group?

### **INTRODUCTION – WHERE YOU FIND MIRACLES**

#### **QUESTIONS**

Steve said that we all have miracle needs and we were created to need God's help. Miracles are things that only He can do. What do you need God to do for you?

#### **1. IN THE HOLY PLACE**

God wants to reveal His plan to us.

#### **QUESTIONS**

Are we actually looking in the right place? Do we even bother to look? Steve said that we won't find God in front of the TV. We need to enter into His presence. Are we doing this?

Take some time to pray together and wait on God as a group. You may like to put on some 'Worship' music to help people to focus on God.

#### **2. IN YOUR HEART**

Steve said that we need a heart full of promises.

#### **QUESTIONS**

Go around the group and share a piece of scripture that holds specific significance to you and share why.

#### **3. IN THE HEAVENLIES**

We need to declare our dreams to the heavens.

#### **QUESTIONS**

Thank God together and declare the truth of His promises for us.

#### **4. IN YOUR HEAD**

Steve said that our greatest enemy is often our own mind.

#### **QUESTIONS**

Have we allowed lies to stop us asking for or believing for a miracle? Why don't we expect miracles?
